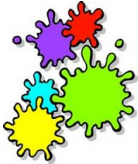


All age family worship & Sunday Club

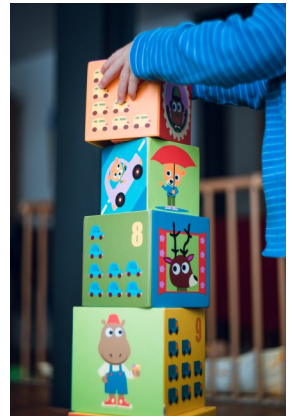

Saint Luke's Church Tiptree Activities for Carers & Children

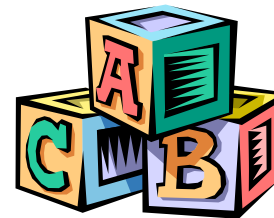
Saint Luke's Parent & Toddler Group
