OUR CHURCH

Since our last stewardship campaign in 2012 we have:

- ♦ Completed the reordering of the Chancel
- Employed a parish administrator
- Established Messy Church

In the coming year(s) we hope to:

- Develop our follow-up of baptism recently bereaved
- ♦ Build on our existing youth and children's work
- Refurbish the church extension.

In 2014, each week, we spent:

- £1,007 on our share of clergy, stipend, housing and training and support costs.
- £335 on our buildings, including insurance, heat light, general maintenance etc.
- £144 on worship and ministry costs to and in the community.
- £153 on other costs

In 2014 each week we received:

- £835 from regular giving and collections
- £243 from HM Revenue & Customs from Gift Aided donations and giving
- £216 from fees
- £291 from the extension
- £54 from fundraising
- £69 from all other income

(the above based on our unrestricted funds)

How to decide how much to give

There is no easy formula - It is up to each one of us to decide prayerfully how much we can afford to give, but we should make a conscious decision rather than giving to God the loose change in our pockets at the end of the day.

The church here needs £1,782 per week in 2015 for its ministry of worship, witness, service & mission.

In 2014 our weekly income was £1,708

In order to meet this shortfall and for this ministry to be adequately funded we need the grace of giving.
